DAY 1: WELCOME TO CANADA!


Arrive in Calgary, AB, for dinner and overnight stay. *D*

DAY 2: CALGARY/BANFF

Begin with a sightseeing tour along the route from Calgary to Banff with stops at various viewpoints for your first glimpse of the Canadian Rockies. The breathtaking views will not stop here as you ascend 2,292 feet up Sulphur Mountain in an enclosed gondola cabin. The next two nights you will call Banff your home away from home. *B, D*

DAY 3: LAKE LOUISE/YOHO NATIONAL PARK/EMERALD LAKE

Morning sightseeing takes us to natural elements that have defined the look of this area of the Rocky Mountains. Highlights will include Lake Louise, Yoho National Park, and Moraine Lake, where the Valley of Ten Peaks offers breathtaking, unforgettable views. A feat to behold are the Spiral Railway tunnels—engineers circled the track to gain elevation, which results in freight trains crossing over themselves! Enjoy a lunch included at Emerald Lake Lodge, set on a private island amongst the beautiful turquoise waters of Emerald Lake. This afternoon, enjoy wandering the quaint streets of Banff before a relaxing dinner on your own. *B, L*

DAY 4: ICEFIELDS PARKWAY/COLUMBIA ICEFIELD

Ice is the theme of today's touring as you travel north along the scenic Icefields Parkway from Banff to Jasper. Numerous photo stops will be made along the way as you pass Bow Lake, Athabasca Falls, and the Columbia Icefields. Board an all-terrain Ice Explorer and venture onto the surface of the Athabasca Glacier, where you will step out and walk on the ancient ice itself. An unforgettable experience atop a glacier that feeds into three oceans, a true hydrological apex! Later, take in the spectacular scenery of the Sunwapta Valley from a 918-foot glacier skywalk. **B, L**

DAY 5: JASPER

Join our expert for a guided tour through the breathtaking Jasper area. Enjoy the mirror-like waters of Pyramid Lake and Patricia Lake, set beneath the impressive Pyramid Mountain and flanked by the slopes of the Victoria Cross Ranges. Revere iconic Maligne Lake and at Athabasca viewpoint marvel at sweeping views of the Athabasca River with snow-capped peaks of majestic Mount Tekarra; an unforgettable showcase of the Canadian Rockies. **B, L**

DAY 6: ROCKY MOUNTAINEER RAILWAY TO KAMLOOPS

All aboard! Experience some of North America's most stunning scenery while indulging in luxurious GoldLeaf service on the famed Rocky Mountaineer train. Guided by the Rocky Mountaineer team, take in the views of towering Mount Robson, tumbling Pyramid Falls, and the winding North Thompson River. Enjoy local cuisine prepared directly on the train while viewing picture worthy scenery. Your day concludes as the Rocky Mountaineer glides into Kamloops. **B, L**

In Gastown, see the marvelous steam-powered clock and Vancouver's Olympic legacy at the Olympic Cauldron. At a local Public Market, you can choose from a variety of local food vendors for lunch.
