### DAY 1: OHIO


Head east to central Ohio for dinner and an overnight stay. *D*

#### DAY 4: MOUNT VERNON

Step back in time at Mount Vernon, the home of George Washington. Built by his father, Augustine Washington, in 1734, the estate became Washington's home in 1754, marking the beginning of his storied legacy. Explore the beautifully restored mansion, wander through lush gardens, and discover fascinating exhibits, including the final resting place of the Washingtons. Take in the peaceful views of the Potomac River, making this visit a perfect blend of history and natural beauty. **B, L**
