Door County is the Midwest's own slice of coastal paradise—where stunning natural beauty meets rich heritage. Uncover its magic with a scenic tour of Peninsula State Park, Wisconsin's crown jewel, and the captivating Whitefish Dunes, where towering sand dunes and ancient limestone caves line the shoreline. Wander the charming streets of Fish Creek, celebrated as the country's most walkable village, and sip award-winning wines during a guided tasting at the historic von Stiehl Winery. And, of course, a visit to Door County isn't complete without an authentic fish boil at sunset.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO WISCONSIN!

Nestled along the shores of Lake Michigan, the picturesque town of Port Washington exudes the charm of a New England fishing village. Enjoy a delightful evening with dinner just a stone's throw from the lake and brimming with cozy coastal vibes. **D**

DAY 2: STURGEON BAY

For a touch of adventure, climb the historic Port Washington Lighthouse (optional) and soak in sweeping views of the lake. Then, journey north to Manitowoc for a visit to the Wisconsin Maritime Museum, where a docent-led tour of the USS *Cobia*, America's most fully restored WWII submarine, offers a fascinating glimpse into naval history. In the afternoon, sip award-winning vintages at the scenic von Stiehl Winery, Wisconsin's oldest, perched above the charming Algoma Harbor. Later, unwind with some leisurely free time in the beautiful lakeside town of Sturgeon Bay before settling in at the elegant Stone Harbor Resort. **B, D**

DAY 3: FISH CREEK

Set off on a scenic drive through Peninsula State Park, the crown jewel of Wisconsin's state parks. Enjoy a guided tour of one of the park's five iconic lighthouses before heading to the vibrant village of Fish Creek. Stroll through quaint galleries, unique boutiques, and cozy outdoor cafés. Then, dive into the spirit of Door County with a captivating Fish Creek Boat Tour. Marvel at the stately




homes lining the famed “Millionaire’s Row,” and uncover fascinating stories of Sven’s Bluff, the early 1900s girls’ Camp Menagha, and the European pioneers who left their mark on Door County’s rich history. Cap off this unforgettable day with an authentic Door County fish boil and enjoy the famous “boil over” as you savor a meal steeped in local tradition. **B, D**

DAY 4: DOOR COUNTY

Explore the stunning Lake Michigan side of the peninsula, where sandy beaches meet beautiful rocky cliffs. Begin with a tour of Björklunden’s enchanting Boynton Chapel, a hidden gem nestled in the woods. Then, take a peaceful walk along the shoreline of Whitefish Dunes State Park, where you’ll uncover the fascinating story of the limestone sea caves carved by centuries of waves. Next, head to Sister Bay for a one-of-a-kind lunch at the iconic Al Johnson’s Swedish Restaurant, famous for its delicious Scandinavian fare *and* the goats casually grazing on the grass-covered roof! As evening falls, unwind at your own pace back at the Resort. Whether you prefer a lakeside stroll or a wander through the charming streets of Sturgeon Bay, the evening is yours to enjoy. **B, L**

DAY 5: LAMBEAU FIELD/ ONEIDA NATION

Say goodbye to the charm of Door County as we make our way to Green Bay for an exclusive, behind-the-scenes tour of the legendary Lambeau Field, home to the storied Green Bay Packers and their Hall of Fame, embarking on a journey through more than a century of football history and one-of-a-kind artifacts. Learn why the story of this team continues to inspire fans of all generations from around the country. Then, delve into the rich heritage and culture of the Oneida Nation with a meaningful visit to a vibrant Native community, where you’ll gain insight into the traditions, history, and resilience. From there, continue to Racine to indulge in a beloved local delicacy, crafted with care and tradition passed down through generations. **B, D**
