DAY 3: BILTMORE ESTATE

See America's largest private home, the picturesque Biltmore Estate, one of the most prominent remaining examples of the Gilded Age. Enjoy a day exploring the home's 250 rooms including 33 bedrooms, 43 bathrooms, and 3 kitchens. Eat lunch on the grounds of the Estate before visiting the Biltmore Winery. Finish the day at leisure in beautiful Asheville, North Carolina! **B, L**

DAY 4: GREAT SMOKY MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK, PIGEON FORGE

Experience the vivid 11,000-year-old story of human history during a morning visit to the Museum of Cherokee People. Visit the Oconaluftee Visitor Center, the gateway to the Smoky Mountains, before a local guide leads us through this ecological wonderland. Pass through the heart of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park bursting with gorgeous fall foliage. Finish the day at the Titanic Museum, where you can explore the ship's captivating artifacts and stories, then savor a unique dining experience aboard the legendary vessel. **B, D**
