DAY 2: HISTORIC PHILADELPHIA

DAY 3: PHILADELPHIA FLOWER SHOW

Today is dedicated to the Philadelphia Flower Show! Take the entire day to discover the nation's largest and longest-running horticultural event, which has been operating since 1829. Explore the acres of garden displays designed by world-renowned landscape artists and view the artistic floral arranging competition. **B**

DAY 4: LONGWOOD GARDENS, HAGLEY MUSEUM

This morning, depart Philadelphia and travel towards the Brandywine Valley, a lush, historic region known as "America's Garden Capital." Immerse yourself in the beauty of Longwood Gardens, one of the world's premier horticultural display gardens. Continue on to the Hagley Museum and Library, the site of the gunpowder works founded by E.I. du Pont in 1802. Tour the du Pont home, learn about the history of American Innovation, and take in the natural beauty along the Brandywine River. This evening, enjoy a farewell dinner with your fellow travelers. **B, D**

DAY 5: FAREWELL

Discover the Philadelphia Magic Gardens, the largest work created by mosaic artist Isaiah Zagar. The tiled passages of the Magic Gardens create an over-3,000 square foot mosaic display. Then, depart Philadelphia with fond memories and new friends. **B** ☀
