DAY 1: KEARNEY, NE

Your trip begins with a comfortable ride to Kearney, NE. Step into history at the remarkable Great Platte River Road Archway Monument. Spanning the interstate, this immersive museum brings pioneer trails, the Pony Express, and early transportation routes to life. Enjoy dinner together in this unique setting. **D**

DAY 2: RAWLINS, WY

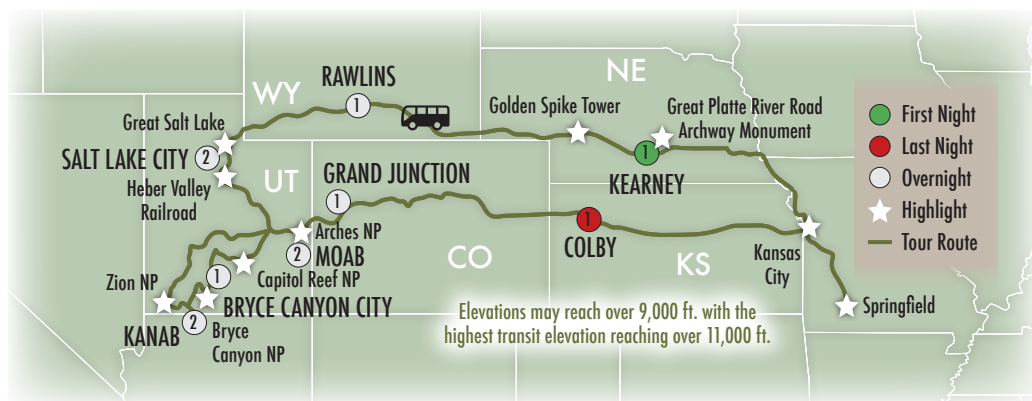
Follow the path of the rails westward, stopping at Golden Spike Tower for a bird's-eye view of the world's largest rail yard. Continue to Cheyenne to explore railroad heritage, including an up-close look at a massive Big Boy steam engine. End the day in Rawlins, surrounded by Wyoming's rugged beauty. **B, L**

DAY 3: SALT LAKE CITY, UT

Cross sweeping Wyoming landscapes and the Continental Divide into Utah. After lunch, a city tour reveals the unique history, architecture, and mountain backdrop of the State's Capitol, Salt Lake City. **B, L**

DAY 4: THE GREAT SALT LAKE, HEBER VALLEY RAILROAD

Today, experience the natural wonder of the Great Salt Lake and the beauty of Antelope Island, where wildlife and wildflowers can be seen in the Spring. Then, "all aboard" the Heber Valley Railroad for a scenic ride with incredible views of the Wasatch Back Mountains and the beautiful Heber Valley. **B**



DAY 5: MOAB, UT

Journey across Utah's dramatic desert scenery to Moab, your gateway to some of the most iconic landscapes in the country. Check into your Moab hotel for the first of two nights. **B, L**

DAY 6: ARCHES AND CANYONLANDS NATIONAL PARKS

Today, is filled with awe-inspiring sights as you explore Arches and Canyonlands National Park, where natural stone arches, deep canyons, and vast mesas stretch as far as the eye can see. **B, D**

DAY 7: CAPITOL REEF NATIONAL PARK

Experience Capitol Reef National Park along the 8-mile scenic drive that runs alongside the unusual Waterpocket Fold, a "wrinkle" in the earth's crust. Explore the historic Fruita district, an oasis in the heart of the park, featuring 19th-century buildings and abundant orchards. **B, D**

DAY 8: BRYCE CANYON NATIONAL PARK

Today, is devoted to the otherworldly beauty of Bryce Canyon National Park, famous for its irregular and colorful hoodoos, spires and breathtaking vistas. Despite its name, it is not a true canyon, but a series of natural horseshoe-shaped amphitheaters. **B, D**

DAY 9: ZION NATIONAL PARK

Spend the day in Zion National Park, where you'll enjoy lunch, a scenic tram ride, and unforgettable views of soaring canyon walls. Take some time to venture into "the Narrows," saunter along the Riverside trail, or enjoy an ice cream at Zion Lodge. **B, L**

DAY 10: GRAND JUNCTION, CO

Turn eastward and travel toward Grand Junction today, taking in the final red desert views. See the landscape begin to change as you cross into Colorado. Sleep in the shadow of Grand Mesa in Grand Junction, CO. **B, D**

DAY 11: THE PLAINS

Continue across Colorado and marvel at the views through Glenwood Canyon. Traverse the Continental Divide and come down out of the Rockies onto the Great Plains of Eastern Colorado and Western Kansas. Arrive in Colby, KS, for your final overnight. **B, D**

DAY 12: RETURN HOME

Return with a camera full of photos and a heart full of memories—from historic railroads to majestic national parks, desert sunsets to mountain horizons. **B** ☀
